WHERE CAN I FIND ALTESYS CATALOGUES, PHOTOS AND OTHER MARKETING MATERIAL?


Altesys international partners and distributors need to be self sufficient and productive in executing the tasks such as the following:

- **Marketing/promotion**
 - Customer-specific PRESENTATIONS
 - Illustrated sheets for paper and E-MAILING
 - local language short-form CATALOGUES
 - PRESS RELEASES
 - Local language PRICE LISTS and QUOTATIONS
 - MARKETING BULLETINS.
- **Technical**
 - Learn/control/teach others AMPLIFIER set-up procedures
 - Learn/control/teach others DIRECT HEADSET SELECTION
 - Establish telephone/headset COMPATIBILITIES.

For this reason, Altesys provides access to a web-hosted archive, where everybody can find very useful material for downloading. Access is from the Restricted Area of the [Altesys Website](#) home page.

HOW CAN I ACCES THE ALTESYS RESTRICTED AREA?

First of all, you have to request your personal USER ID and Password on <http://www.altesys.com/>.



Once you have completed and sent the form with the requested information, your first registration data will be sent to your e-mail address as a reminder.

Finally, you supply your UserID and Password to the restricted area box in [Altesys.com Home Page](#).

WHAT CAN I FIND IN THE RESTRICTED AREA?

Once in the Restricted Area, you can access the Altesys Web Archive, where you can find various materials:

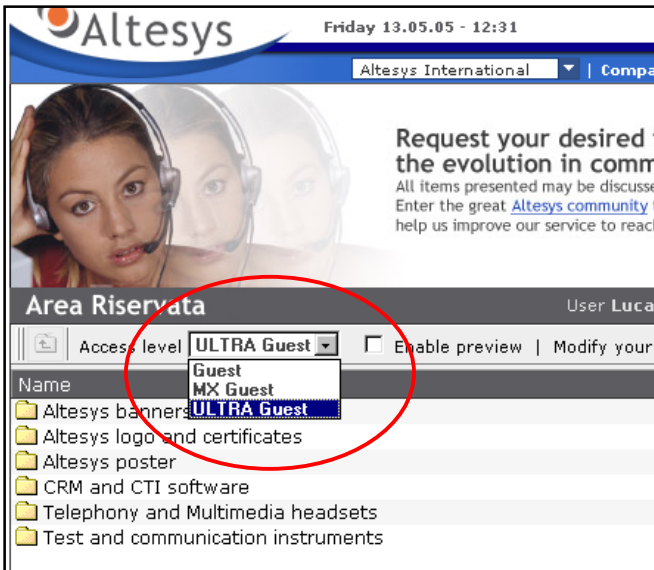
There are 3 different access levels and each level provides you access to different specific type of information: soon after registration you will receive a default **Guest Account**. Later, subject to approval from you account manager, you may be upgraded to a higher Account permission level.

For example, the following table illustrates the 3 different access levels in the "Telephony and Multimedia Headsets" category:

For example : a "Guest" user can download Price lists, but not Marketing Bulletins. An "Ultra" user, on the other hand, can download Posters, but not Price Lists: he has to temporarily reduce his level (a menu bar is provided for this in the top left of the page).



F.A.Q.:

- How Can I became a MX or Ultra Guest?
 - These access levels are reserved for regular distributors and Altesys partners. To obtain these access permissions please send an email to your account manager or info@altesys.com.
- Can I change my UserID or password?
 - Yes, anybody can change his username and password just clicking on *Modify your personal data*, in the Restricted Area.
